

Are you dead – or alive?

God's word says in *Ephesians 2:1* "And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins."

If you are not saved, you are dead in trespasses and sins.

The Bible goes on to say that if you will receive Christ as your personal Savior, you will be quickened.

That word "quicken" simply means to be "made alive".

Ephesians 2: 4 and 5 says: "But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us. Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved)."

Sin separates us from God, but God has a simple plan of salvation.

Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

You cannot save yourself.

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

You can be saved right now by simply calling upon the name of the Lord.

Romans 10:13 "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

You must be willing to receive Christ, and you must believe God raised Jesus from the dead.

Romans 10: 9 and 10 "That if thou shalt confess with the mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
